## SET is Required for all Volunteers

*Called To Protect Training for Ministers is required for:*

All new volunteers in Parish Ministry  
and for

Any volunteer who has not previously attended this  
3 hour introductory session.

All persons attending Called To Protect for Ministers training will be expected to complete a Volunteer Application and sign the Code of Ethics.

The Volunteer Application includes a volunteer history and does ask for five personal references: (one professional/civic, two personal and two family members).

In preparation, please bring with you to the training, the addresses and phone numbers for the locations you have volunteered and for your references.

- Every adult volunteer serving in any capacity that directly involves minors.
- All paid personnel whether employed in areas of ministry or kind of service by the Diocese of Phoenix, Parishes, Schools, Catholic Cemeteries, Mount Claret, Newman Centers or SVDP.
- All priests, seminarians and deacons.

#### Every Other Year for:

All other volunteers whose service does not directly involve minors.
